Meeting called to order by Chairman Merritt at 7-30PM.

Motion to accept the minutes from the February 2009 meeting made by G. Cleveland, seconded by M. Boice. – Approved.

Correspondence: No correspondence received.

Old Business:

Chairman Merritt asked when the street painting was scheduled for 2009. His concern is that the parking spot in front of Garf's Deli that the commission recommended be removed is still there. The commission had recommended that the space be removed and a space be put in where the cross walk had been removed in the middle of the block so the business district did not lose a parking space.

G. Cleveland ascertained what the status was in removing the left turn arrow on the pavement leaving the old A&P parking lot onto North Broad St. I advised I had sent an e-mail to Mr. Batista from Benderson Corp last year and was advised it would be removed and when they took care of the parking lot they repainted the right turn arrow and did not paint the left turn arrow, however the left turn arrow is still visible. T. Knapp asked if there was any mention if it was feasible for the City sign which reads "no left turn" could be moved closer to the turning area as we had requested, so it would be more visible. I advised it was in the minutes when we discussed it but no further action had been taken on this matter.

Chairman Merritt reminded we still had one opening on the traffic commission that has not been filled. He states he has been unable to find anyone to fill the slot and requested we continue to attempt to locate someone willing to be on the committee.

New Business:

Chairman Merritt advised he observed that North Front St has been blocked off and was ascertaining on if anyone heard when the NBT project in that area was going to be started. No one had heard when the project was going to get started.

With no further business to be discussed, G. Cleveland made the motion to adjourn seconded by T. Knapp.
