Minutes of the November meeting were approved as written.

C. Sprague suggested that the Commission be involved in the County meetings that would involve the downtown Parks.

R. DeMarko read a rough draft letter thanking NBT for the donation to repair the Kiosk. It will be forwarded to NBT for approval and publication.
