Chairperson Linda Hason called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. A quorum was present. Motion by Vivian James to accept the minutes from June 12, 2024, meeting, Seconded by Frank Revoir.

Correspondence:

Brandon Clarke, Achieve representative, Clarke advised the traffic commission, Achieve has about 30 employees, 10-12 vans and about 80 participants daily that cross West Midland Drive or are in the area. Clarke requested a marked crosswalk from the east side of the Achieve to the parking lot on the east side of West Midland Dr. This would alert motorists coming from East Main Street to the pedestrians' traffic ahead. Clarke also requested the traffic commission review the intersection of West Midland Dr./Griffin Street to see if Stop sign would help control on West Midland.

Old Business:

Common Council sent back the request made by the traffic commission make one parking slot on West Main Street on the South side of West Park handicapped parking. Alderman Zieno explained why the motion was sent back. Richard Natoli made a motion to rescind the original

motion to make one parking slot into a handicapped parking slot. Motion by Richard Natoli to add one additional parking slot on West Main Street, east of Court Street into a handicapped parking slot. Seconded by Vivian James. All in favor. Motion sent back to common council.

NEW BUSINESS:

Request from Brandon Clarke, Achieve for the crosswalk and Stop sign on West Midland Drive.

Chenango County requested two parking slots in the Henry Street City Parking lot in the northwest corner to add two additional EV charging station. The office of the Aging is purchasing four EV vehicles and the additional charging stations would help keep the fleet charged and available for meal delivery. Motion by Frank Revoir to support Chenango County by allowing access to the two parking slots for the installation of the charging station. Second by Richard Natoli. All in favor. Motion sent to common council.
