Old Business:

Proposed Hotel Project

- Committee discussed the proposed hotel project.
- No action taken at this time; matter remains pending while awaiting additional developments.

NEW BUSINESS:

Columbia Street Parking Review

- Committee discussed reviewing parking patterns on Columbia Street.
- Noted the need to study which side of the street vehicles park on most frequently.
- Committee discussed ensuring there is clear support from residents on the street.
- Decision anticipated to be made in January.

Wrong-Way Parking Concerns (Pleasant Street)

- Committee discussed complaints regarding vehicles parking in the wrong direction on Pleasant Street.
- Question raised regarding whether wrong-way parking is prohibited by law.
- Concerns noted due to resident complaints.

Business District Parking Concerns

- Committee discussed communication to Scott and Matt related to parking concerns in the Business District.
- Discussion included possibly involving a backup representative and the possibility of scheduling a meeting.

NEW BUSINESS (CONTINUED)

Stop Signs / No Parking Sign Request

- Committee discussed which intersection stop signs and/or no parking signs could be added or changed.
- No action taken on citizen complaint (tabled at this time).

Diagonal Striping – Hale / Frontice / Midland

- Committee discussed the possibility of diagonal striping at/near the Hale / Frontice / Midland area.
- Possible coordination with Tim Miller was discussed.

Alternate Overnight Winter Parking

- Committee discussed alternate parking options for overnight parking during the winter, as opposed to full no-parking restrictions.

- Committee noted potential benefits to improve tenant quality of life and in relation to the hotel project.
