ORDINANCE NO. 3
OF 1995

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CERTAIN WATER AND THE SEWER USE RATES
IN THE CITY OF NORWICH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Norwich, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The water use rate is hereby established as follows:

Per Quarter

Minimum Charge up to 1,000 cubic feet	{ \$17.99 }	<u>\$19.60</u>
Additional Charge per 100 cubic feet		
1,000 to 13,000 cubic feet	{ 1.48 }	<u>1.60</u>
13,000 to 50,000 cubic feet	{ 1.36 }	<u>1.50</u>
50,000 and over	{ 1.14 }	<u>1.30</u>

Fire Service

1 1/2 inch service	{ 55.83 }	<u>60.00</u>
6 inch service	{ 109.66 }	<u>110.00</u>
8 inch service	{ 185.59 }	<u>190.00</u>
12 inch service	{ 217.42 }	<u>220.00</u>

Hydrant Charges

Per Each Hydrant	{ 54.36 }	<u>55.00</u>
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Section 2. The sewer use rate is hereby established at {2.19}\$ 2.26 per 100 cubic feet.

New Material is underlined, {bracketed} material is deleted.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1996, shall be reflected in the billing of March 1, 1996, due and payable March 30, 1996, and shall amend previous ordinances establishing rates for such services.
