ORDINANCE NO. (6)
OF 1999

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CERTAIN WATER AND SEWER USE
RATES IN THE CITY OF NORWICH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Norwich, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The water use rate is hereby established as follows:

Per Quarter		
Minimum Charge up to 1,000 cubic feet	{ \$23.99 }	<u>\$28.57</u>
Additional Charge per 100 cubic feet		
1,000 to 13,000 cubic feet	{ 1.96 }	<u>2.33</u>
13,000 to 50,000 cubic feet	{ 1.86 }	<u>2.29</u>
50,000 and over	{ 1.64 }	<u>2.10</u>

1 ½ inch service	60.00	
6 inch service	110.00	
8 inch service	190.00	
12 inch service	220.00	
Hydrant Charge

Section 2. The sewer use rate is hereby established at \$2.45 per 100 cubic feet.

Section 3. Quarterly bills not paid by the 15th day of the succeeding month will be considered past due and a five percent (5%) late fee will be applied to the balance.

Section 4. Monthly bills not paid by the 1st day of the succeeding month will be considered past due and a three point two five percent (3.25%) late fee will be applied to the balance.

Section 5. The Common Council may, from time to time as necessary, adopt formal policies under which service to both quarterly and monthly account may be terminated for non-payment.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2000 and shall amend previous ordinances establishing rates for such services.

McNeil moved to receive the proposed General Fund, Water Fund, Wastewater Fund, Special Grants Fund, Unemployment Insurance Reserve Fund and Debt Service Fund Budgets and set public hearings for 7 PM on November 16, 1999. Seconded by Ald. Rabinowitz and duly adopted, ayes all on a roll call vote, 6-0.
