

ORDINANCE #2021-01 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH  
ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BOROUGH CODE SECTION 369-15”

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH  
ARLINGTON, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY THAT:

WHEREAS, the Board of Health have determined that there is a need to amend  
the Code of the Borough of North Arlington; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the  
Borough of North Arlington, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

That Sections 369-15 of the Health Code shall be amended as follows (additions marked  
by “bold” and deletions marked by “—“):

**§ 369-15 Release from quarantine.**

The Board shall may require that the animal shall not be released from quarantine  
until written proof of a licensed veterinarian's examination on the tenth day of  
quarantine and no later than the 15th day of quarantine stating that the animal is in  
good health. Said proof is to be furnished to the Health Officer or other Board of  
Health employee designated by the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of the Code of the Borough of  
North Arlington shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances  
inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that if any parts, sections, provisions, or the total  
of any of the above provisions are held to be invalid or unenforceable in any court, the  
findings or judgments of which court are applicable to the State of New Jersey, the  
balance and remainder of such provisions shall remain in full force and effect as an  
Ordinance of the Borough of North Arlington; and

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE AFTER  
PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW.
