**ORDINANCE NO. 2453
BOROUGH OF NORTH ARLINGTON
BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 187 OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF NORTH ARLINGTON ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO ADD AN
ADDITIONAL STOP SIGN AND INTERSECTION WHERE PARKING SHALL BE
PROHIBITED**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that, on the recommendation of the North Arlington Police Chief, that it is in the interest of public safety to amend that section of Chapter 187 of the Code of the Borough of North Arlington entitled "Parking prohibited at all times: stop signs" in order to add the stop sign located at Arlington Boulevard at the intersection of that street with River Road; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:48-2 provides the Borough Council with the authority to pass ordinances for the "preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Arlington, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, that Section 187-4.1 of the North Arlington Borough

Code entitled "Parking prohibited at all times: stop signs" which bans vehicles from parking, stopping or idling within 50 feet of a posted stop sign, shall be amended to add the following street and intersection:


Stop sign on: Arlington Boulevard. **Intersection with:** River Road.


IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Chapter 187 of the Code of the Borough of North Arlington shall remain in full force and effect; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that if any part, sections, provisions, or the total of any of the above provisions are held to be invalid or unenforceable in any court, the findings or judgments of which court are applicable to the State of New Jersey, the balance and remainder of such provisions shall remain in full force and effect as an Ordinance of the Borough of North Arlington; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after the adoption and publication according to law.
