**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 187 OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF NORTH ARLINGTON ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO ADD A
NEW ARTICLE REGULATING PARKING ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS WITHIN THE
BOROUGH**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that there is a need to amend Chapter 187 of the Code of the Borough of North Arlington entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" in order to establish a new article of said Chapter regulating the use of parking enforcement cameras within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:48-2 provides the Borough Council with the authority to pass ordinances for the "preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Arlington, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, that a new article shall be added to Chapter 187 of the Code of the Borough of North Arlington entitled "Pedestrian Safety Monitoring" to read as follows:

A. Purpose.

The Borough has deployed pedestrian safety monitoring technology (also known as parking enforcement cameras) at various locations to monitor parking activity, protect pedestrians and enforce parking regulations in certain no-parking zones such as fire hydrants, bus stops, crosswalks, and loading zones. Zones where pedestrian safety monitoring technology is deployed shall be known as Pedestrian Safety Zones.

B. Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates the provisions of this section of the Code shall be punished by a fine in the amount of \$60. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day the vehicle remains parked in violation of this article. No court appearance is necessary.

C. Removal of vehicles.

Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this article shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any police officer and or peace officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal, before regaining possession of the vehicle.

D. Enforcement.


Enforcement of this article and further rules and regulations, as may be promulgated from time to time, shall be under the jurisdiction the Police Department of the Borough of North Arlington or the Parking Enforcement Officers of the Borough of North Arlington.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Chapter 187 of the Code of the Borough of North Arlington shall remain in full force and effect; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that if any part, sections, provisions, or the total of any of the above provisions are held to be invalid or unenforceable in any court, the findings or judgments of which court are applicable to the State of New Jersey, the balance and remainder of such provisions shall remain in full force and effect as an Ordinance of the Borough of North Arlington; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after the adoption and publication according to law.
