A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF NORWOOD TO AUTHORIZE A PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, SECTION 3-c FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 VILLAGE BUDGET

SECTION 1: Purpose and Intent

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Village of Norwood pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c, and to allow the Village of Norwood to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2020-2021 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law §3-c. The Board is obligated to prepare a responsible budget, which meets the Village's mandated obligations and delivers the high level of services that residents expect, while minimizing the tax burden on taxpayers.

SECTION 2: Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law, Section 3-c, which authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said governing body.

SECTION 3. Tax Limit Override

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Norwood is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2022 that requires a property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law,

SECTION 4. Severability

If any provision of this local law is held to be invalid or unenforceable in whole or in part, such invalidity or unenforceability shall attach only to such provision or part thereof and the remaining part of such provision and all such other provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. Effective Date

This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
