RELATIVE TO LEFT TURN PROHIBITIONS

An Ordinance of the City of Northampton, Massachusetts. Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Northampton, in City Council assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1

That the § 312-115 of the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

§ 312-115 Schedule XIV: Left Turns Prohibited.

Left turns shall be prohibited in the following locations:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Left Turn Prohibited Onto
Elm Street [Added 10-18-1990]	Southeast	Woodlawn Avenue
North Elm Street	North	Elm Street
Woodlawn Avenue [Added 10-18-1990]	Southwest	Elm Street

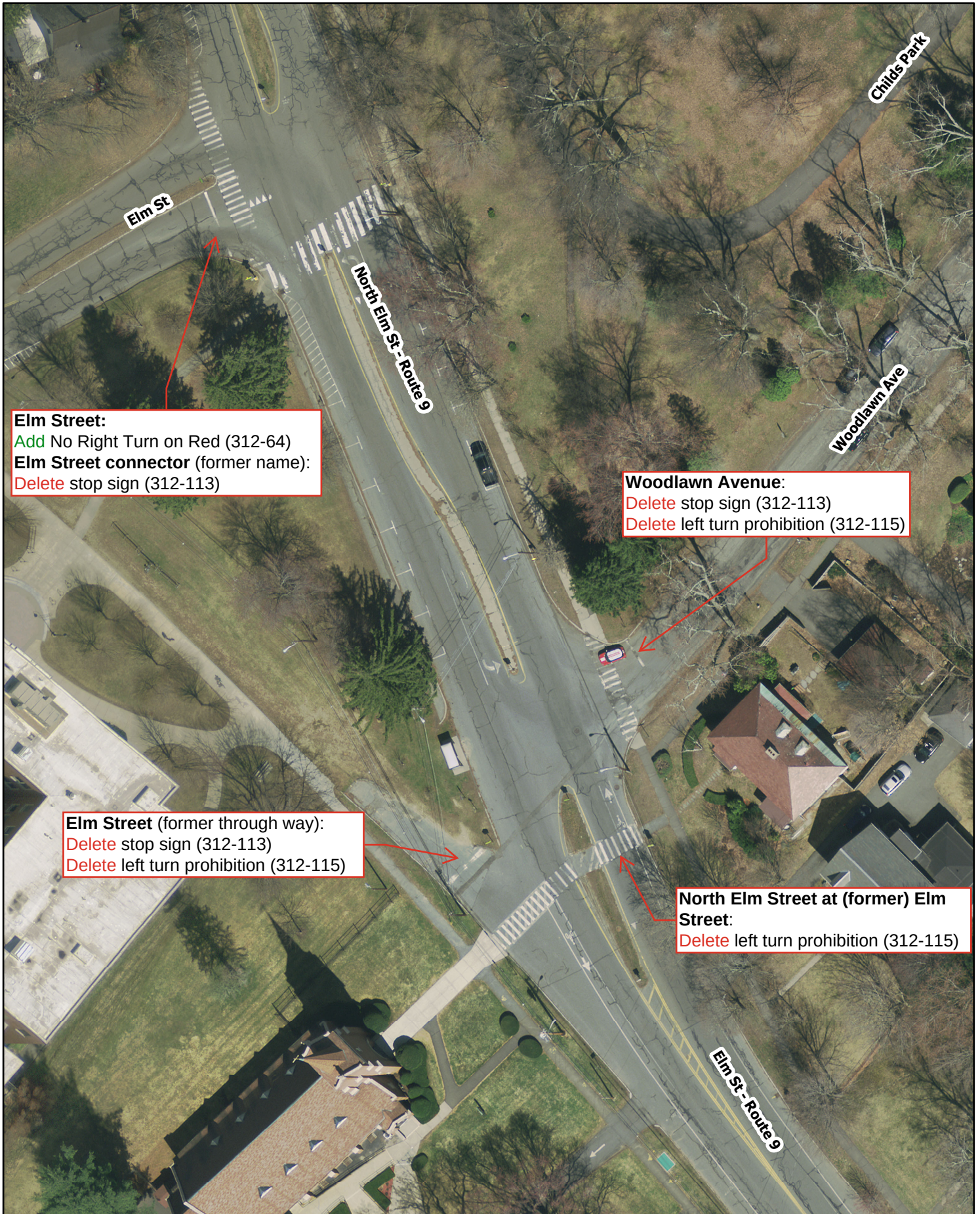
