ORDINANCE NO. 932

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF NORTH EAST, ERIE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS
AND ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS**

WHEREAS, The Borough Council of North East Borough; Erie County, Pennsylvania, subsequent to extensive investigation and deliberation, is of the opinion that the streets within the Borough of North East, Erie County, Pennsylvania require the establishment of regulations governing the operation of motorized vehicles and implements upon the streets, roads, highways, trafficways, sidewalks, and public parking lots of the Borough of North East; and

WHEREAS, The Borough Council of North East Borough; Erie County, Pennsylvania is required to create or amend Ordinances, from time to time, to meet the needs of the community as required by § 3323 (b) of the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa C.S.A. §3323 (b); and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North East, Erie County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS

Words and phrases, when used in this ordinance, except for sections or parts to which different or additional definitions apply, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 101 et seq., except that in this ordinance the word "street" may be used interchangeably with the word "roadway," and shall have the same meaning as the word "roadway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

- A) **One Way Street**- Street or specific lanes upon which vehicular traffic shall proceed in one (1) direction at all or such times as shall be indicated by official traffic-control devices.
- B) **Stop-controlled intersection** – A stop-controlled intersection is a type of sign-controlled intersections where vehicles entering the intersection from a street that has a stop sign installed must come to a complete stop and yield to cross traffic before going through the intersection. Entrance into these intersections from one or more approaches is controlled by a stop sign.

SECTION 2: ONE-WAY STREETS

The following Borough Street is established as a one-way street, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any one-way street other than in the direction established for traffic on that street.

Street	From	To	Direction of Travel
Colfax Street	Grant Street	Clay Street	South

SECTION 3: STOP INTERSECTIONS

The following intersection is hereby declared to be a stop intersection and official stop signs shall be erected in such position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street (the intersection or through street) on the first-named street (the stop street) in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first-named or stop street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by §3323 (b) of the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §3323 (b), and shall not proceed into or across the second named or intersecting or through street until he/she has followed all applicable requirements of that Section of the law

Stop Street	Intersecting or Through Street	Direction of Travel
Gibson Street	Park Street	East and West

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its provisions shall be held invalid, the same shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions of the Ordinance which would have been enacted had such invalid provisions been included herein.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This is effective immediately upon enactment according to law, and shall remain in effect hereafter until revise, amended, or revoked by action of the Borough of North East
