NORTH NEWTON TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH NEWTON, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 300 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH NEWTON TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP TO INCLUDE PARCEL NO. 30-08-0595-082 ENTIRELY WITHIN THE COMMERICAL-INDUSTRIAL (C-I) DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 65101, et seq., at Section 66516, authorizes North Newton Township (the "Township") to plan for the development of the Township through zoning, subdivision and land development regulations; and

WHEREAS, the North Newton Township Board of Supervisors received an Application for Zoning Amendment requesting that Parcel No. 30-08-0595-082 (the "Property") be placed in the Commercial-Industrial (C-I) District in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, the Property is currently split between the C-I Zoning District and the Rural Residential (R-1) Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors deems it to be in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens to amend the Township of North Newton Zoning Ordinance, as set forth in detail below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of North Newton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, that the North Newton Township Zoning Map is hereby amended as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The North Newton Township Zoning Map, as adopted and made a part of the Township of North Newton Zoning Ordinance at Section 300-12, is hereby amended to include the entirety of the Property located at 35 Ridge Road, Newville, PA 17241, identified as Cumberland County Tax Parcel 30-08-0595-082, within the "C-I" Commercial-Industrial District.

SECTION 2. The North Newton Township Zoning Map shall be changed to reflect the change in zoning as set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance, which amendment shall be made on the official map.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> REPEALER – All provisions of previous ordinances of North Newton Township, or parts thereof, which are contrary or inconsistent to this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> SAVINGS CLAUSE – In all other respects, the provisions of the Township of North Newton Zoning Ordinance shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> SEVERABILITY – The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or part thereof is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or part of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE – This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
