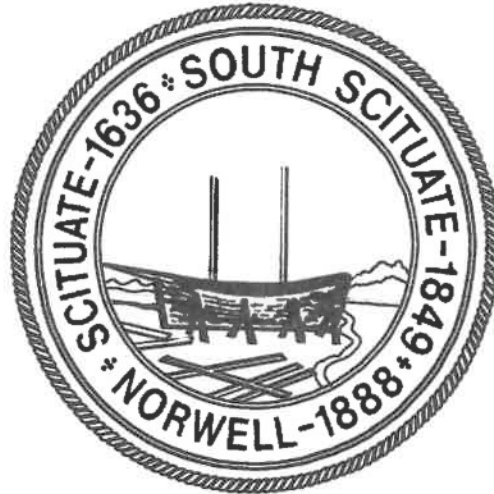
MOTION: Member Turner moved to recommend this proposed amendment to the Aquifer Protection District Bylaw to Town Meeting.
