ORDINANCE NO. 24-CAPITAL-940

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OAKLAND, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$440,000.00 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH .

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Oakland, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Borough, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor:

A. Fiber Optic Network purchase, installation and testing of equipment

Estimated Cost Total: \$103,000.00

B. Network refresh for the Police Department with a VxRail with Horizon environment includes all licensing, hardware, end points, networking equipment, cables, programming and installation

Estimated Cost Total: \$337,000.00

Section 2. The sum of \$440,000.00 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough. The sum of \$440,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements and acquisitions are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
