AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 230.030, SUBSECTION M, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, MISSOURI, REGARDING COLLECTION OF RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 230 of the Municipal Code of the City of Oak Grove, Missouri (the "City Code"), governs the storage and collection of solid waste within the City of Oak Grove (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized pursuant to Section 260.215, RSMo, to adopt ordinances for the storage, collection, transportation, processing or disposal of solid waste within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to amend Section 230.030, subsection M, of the City Code, to permit the collection of residential solid waste from Monday through Friday of each week.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN FOR THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, MISSOURI, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Section 230.030, Subsection M, hereby amended to read as follows:

M. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation collecting residential solid waste to make such collection of residential solid waste except on Monday through Friday of each week, except that when any Federal holiday occurs on a Monday through Friday, collection of residential solid waste shall also be permitted on Saturday of that same week.

**SECTION 2.** That should any sentence, clause, part or provision of the Ordinance be declared by the court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

**SECTION 3.** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
