ORDINANCE NO. 2081

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SURFACING/MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, MISSOURI, AND THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission ("MHTC") has proposed to resurface portions of Broadway/Route F in the downtown area of the City of Oak Grove, Missouri ("City") including the traveled thruway and the adjacent areas where parking is permitted within MHTC right of way (the "parking areas"); and

WHEREAS, in exchange for resurfacing the parking areas, MHTC has requested that the City agree to maintain the parking areas in the future after the resurfacing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to enter into an agreement with MHTC regarding the resurfacing and future maintenance of the parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to enter into cooperative agreements with other governmental entities pursuant to Sections 70.210 to 70.320 RSMo; and

WHEREAS, Section 70.230 RSMo provides that the City may enter into such cooperative agreements by ordinance duly enacted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN FOR THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Surfacing/Maintenance Agreement Between the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission and the City of Oak Grove, Missouri, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved and the Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Oak Grove, Missouri.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

# MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION SURFACING/MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (hereinafter, "Commission") and the **City of Oak Grove**, Missouri (hereinafter, "City").

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Commission proposes to resurface portions of Route F and the area immediately adjacent to the traveled thruway where parking of vehicles is permitted (hereinafter, "parking areas");

WHERAS, the City agrees to maintain the parking areas once the Commission completes resurfacing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and representations in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- (1) <u>PURPOSE:</u> The purpose of this Agreement is for the Commission to resurface portions of Route F, in the City of Oak Grove, Jackson County.
- (2) <u>DESCRIPTION OF ROUTE TO BE RESURFACED:</u> The route to be resurfaced, their locations and widths being as follows:

Route F, from 11<sup>th</sup> street south to 13<sup>th</sup> Street as listed in Job No. J4P3060, Work Order 115.

- (3) <u>DUTIES OF COMMISSION:</u> The Commission will resurface Route F and the area immediately adjacent to the traveled thruway where parking of vehicles are permitted.
- (4) <u>COST OF WORK:</u> The Commission will be solely responsible for the cost of the project.
- (5) <u>MAINTENANCE:</u> After acceptance of the project, the City will accept the responsibility of the maintenance work on the parking areas at its cost, including striping of parking stalls.
- (6) <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>: The City shall not assign, transfer or delegate any interest in this Agreement without the prior written consent of the Commission.

## (7) PERMITS:

- (A) In order to coordinate maintenance activities on the public improvement, the City shall notify the Commission, either by telephone or in writing, prior to performing maintenance work within Commission right of way. Such notification shall be made to the Kansas City's District Traffic Engineer and shall include the location and nature of the work to be performed. Any maintenance activities done by the City which involves closing one or more of the through lanes that may affect the safety of the traveling public, or which will cause permanent changes to the configuration of the improvement, may require a permit from the Commission. The City will be informed of whether or not a permit is required at the time the City notifies Commission of the proposed maintenance activities. The City shall comply with any additional condition placed upon the issuance of the permit.
- (B) All work zone signs and traffic control devices to be used on Commission right of way shall be in accordance in accordance with the latest revision Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices to the extent that the latter is approved by the Commission and the Federal Highway Administration.

# (8) INDEMNIFICATION:

- (A) To the extent allowed or imposed by law, the City shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Commission, including its members and department employees, from any claim or liability whether based on a claim for damages to real or personal property or to a person for any matter relating to or arising out of the City's wrongful or negligent performance of its obligations under this Agreement.
- (B) The City will require any contractor procured by the City to work under this Agreement:
- (1) To obtain a no cost permit from the Commission's District Engineer prior to working on the Commission's right-of-way, which shall be signed by an authorized contractor representative (a permit from the Commission's District Engineer will not be required for work outside of the Commission's right-of-way); and
- (2) To carry commercial general liability insurance and commercial automobile liability insurance from a company authorized to issue insurance in Missouri, and to name the Commission, and the Missouri Department of Transportation and its employees, as additional named insureds in amounts sufficient to cover the sovereign immunity limits for Missouri public entities (\$500,000 per claimant and \$4,000,000 per occurrence) as calculated by the Missouri Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, and published annually in the Missouri Register pursuant to Section 537.610, RSMo.
- (C) In no event shall the language of this Agreement constitute or be construed as a waiver or limitation for either party's rights or defenses with regard to each party's applicable sovereign, governmental, or official immunities and protections as provided by federal and state constitution or law.
- (9) <u>AMENDMENTS</u>: Any change in this Agreement, whether by modification or supplementation, must be accomplished by a formal contract amendment signed and

approved by the duly authorized representatives of the City and the Commission.

- (10) <u>COMMISSION REPRESENTATIVE</u>: The Commission's Kansas City District Engineer is designated as the Commission's representative for the purpose of administering the provisions of this Agreement. The Commission's representative may designate by written notice other persons having the authority to act on behalf of the Commission in furtherance of the performance of this Agreement.
- (11) <u>CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE</u>: The City's Mayor is designated as the City's representative for the purpose of administering the provisions of this Agreement. The City's representative has been given authority by city ordinance attached as Exhibit B and incorporated by reference to this Agreement. The City's representative may designate by written notice other persons having the authority to act on behalf of the City in furtherance of the performance of this Agreement.
- (12) <u>LAW OF MISSOURI TO GOVERN</u>: This Agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Missouri. The City shall comply with all local, state and federal laws and regulations relating to the performance of this Agreement.
- (13) EXECUTIVE ORDER: The City shall comply with all the provisions of Executive Order 07-13, issued by the Honorable Matt Blunt, Governor of Missouri, on the sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) day of March, 2007. This Executive Order, which promulgates the State of Missouri's position to not tolerate persons who contract with the state engaging in or supporting illegal activities of employing individuals who are not eligible to work in the United States, is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Agreement.
- (A) By signing this Agreement, the City hereby certifies that any employee of the City assigned to perform services under the contract is eligible and authorized to work in the United States in compliance with federal law.
- (B) In the event the City fails to comply with the provisions of the Executive Order 07-13, or in the event the Commission has reasonable cause to believe that the City has knowingly employed individuals who are not eligible to work in the United States in violation of federal law, the Commission reserves the right to impose such contract sanctions as it may determine to be appropriate, including but not limited to contract cancellation, termination, or suspension in whole or in part or both.
- (14) <u>INCORPORATION OF PROVISIONS</u>: The City shall include the provisions of paragraph 11 of this Agreement in every subcontract. The City shall take such action with respect to any subcontract as the Commission may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions, including sanctions for noncompliance.
- (15) <u>CANCELLATION</u>: The Commission may cancel this Agreement at any time for a material breach of contractual obligations or for convenience by providing the City with written notice of cancellation. Should the Commission exercise its right to cancel the contract for such reasons, cancellation will become effective upon the date specified in the notice of cancellation sent to the City.

- (16) <u>NOTICES</u>: Any notice or other communication required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed given three (3) days after delivery by United States mail, regular mail postage prepaid, or upon receipt by personal or facsimile delivery, addressed as follows:

or to such other place as the parties may designate in accordance with this Agreement. To be valid, facsimile delivery shall be followed by delivery of the original document, or a clear and legible copy thereof, within three (3) business days of the date of facsimile transmission of that document.

(17) <u>VENUE</u>: It is agreed by the parties that any action at law, suit in equity, or other judicial proceeding to enforce or construe this Agreement, or regarding its alleged breach, shall be instituted only in the Circuit Court of Cole County, Missouri.
