ORDINANCE NO. 2101

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III TRAFFIC CODE, SCHEDULE III PARKING RESTRICTIONS, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, MISSOURI, DESIGNATING LOCATIONS ON BROADWAY AS ACCESSIBLE PARKING FOR PHYSICALLY DISABLED PERSONS.

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2024, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Oak Grove, Missouri, considered certain parking and traffic issues along Broadway in Downtown Oak Grove; and

WHEREAS, Section 355.100 of the Municipal Code of the City of Oak Grove, Missouri ("City Code") establishes regulations for physically disabled parking in the City in accordance with the Revised Statutes of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, in order to further the public health, safety, and welfare, the Board of Aldermen desires that certain Downtown parking locations on Broadway be designated for accessible parking for physically disabled persons pursuant to Section 355.100 of the City Code and the Revised Statutes of Missouri.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Title III Traffic Code, Schedule III Parking Restrictions, of the Municipal Code of the City of Oak Grove, Missouri, is hereby amended to add a new Table III-E Physically Disabled Parking as follows:

Table III- E Physically Disabled Parking

Pursuant to Section 355.100 of Title III Traffic Code, Schedule III Parking Restrictions, of this Municipal Code, parking spaces shall be designated as parking for the physically disabled at the following locations. The City staff is hereby authorized to erect or attach a sign to a pole or the building pursuant to Section 355.100 of the Municipal Code and Section 301.143, RSMo.

Locations

Broadway:

East side of Broadway approximately 90' south of SE 11th Street

East side of Broadway approximately 25' north of SE 13th Street

West side of Broadway approximately 25' south of SW 13th Street

SECTION 2. That should any sentence, clause, part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
