**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 53 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF OLD  
FIELD REGARDING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AND USE OF OTHER  
HUNTING IMPLEMENTS**

**BE IT HEREBY ENACTED**, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Old Field, as follows:

**Section 1. Amendments.**

Chapter 53 (Hunting, Shooting and Trapping), Article I (Hunting and Discharge of Firearms) of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

§ 53-1. Definitions.

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**FIREARM**

Any rifle, pistol, shotgun or muzzleloading firearm which by force of gunpowder, or an airgun as defined in 6 NYCRR 180.3(b), that expels a missile or projectile capable of killing, wounding or otherwise inflicting physical damage upon fish, wildlife or other animals.

§ 53-2. Restrictions on the discharge of firearms and use of hunting implements.

- A. The discharge of firearms and use of other legal hunting implements in the Village shall be governed by Section 11-0931 of the Environmental Conservation Law and 6 NYCRR, Chapter I, Subpart A (Hunting).
- B. Notwithstanding the above, the discharge of firearms is prohibited on a parcel that is less than 10 acres in size.

**Section 2. Severability.**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder hereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part hereof declared by said court to be invalid.

**Section 3. Effective Date.**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the New York Secretary of State.
