ORDINANCE NO. 24-02

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE,
SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE VIII “DAY-CARE PROGRAM” SECTION 160-31
“FEES FOR FULL-DAY SUMMER CAMP”

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Old Bridge, County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

This ordinance amends Article VIII “Day-Care Programs,” Section 160-31 “Fees for Full-Day Summer Camp” of the Code of the Township of Old Bridge, pursuant to the recommendation of the coordinator of said day-care programs.

SECTION 2. ORDINANCE

Be It Ordained that Sections 160-31A. of Article VIII of the Code of the Township of Old Bridge be amended to read as follows [added portions are underlined and bolded; deleted portions have strikethrough]:

§ 160-31 Fees for Full Day Summer Camp.

The tuition fees for the Full Day Summer Camp shall be as follows:

SECTION 3: INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4: PARTIAL INVALIDITY

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

- A. Except as set forth at subparagraphs B and C hereof, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earlier of the following dates: (1) on the date the Mayor affixes his/her signature thereto and returns same to the Municipal Council by delivering it to the Municipal Clerk pursuant to NJSA 40A:69A-41 or (2) on the tenth day following presentment to the Mayor of the Ordinance pursuant to NJSA 40:69A-41 applicable when the Mayor has failed to return the Ordinance; whichever occurs first.
- B. If the Mayor vetoes the Ordinance (in the manner set forth at NJSA 40:69A-41), this Ordinance shall become effective upon the Township Council’s vote to override the Mayor’s veto.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, this Ordinance shall not take effect less than twenty (20) days after its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor, where such approval is required, unless the Council shall have also adopted a resolution declaring an emergency and at least two thirds (2/3) of all the members of the council vote in favor of such resolution.




