

**TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE
ORDINANCE NO. 24-03**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE, SPECIFICALLY
CHAPTER 160, ARTICLE I "RECREATION FEES", §160-2 "HOCKEY LEAGUE; INSTRUCTION
HOCKEY"**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Old Bridge, County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

This ordinance amends Chapter 160, Article I "Recreation Fees," §160-2 "Hockey league; instruction hockey" of the Code of the Township of Old Bridge, pursuant to the recommendation of the Director of Parks and Recreation.

SECTION 2. ORDINANCE

§160-2 B of Chapter 160, Article I of the Code of the Township of Old Bridge be and is hereby amended to read as follows [added portions are underlined and bolded; deleted portions have strikethrough]:

§ 160-2 Hockey league; instruction hockey.

- A. *No changes*
- B. Fees. Pursuant to the recommendation of Old Bridge Township's Director of Recreation, fees for the instructional hockey and hockey league programs are set as follows:

(1) Hockey league.

Program	Resident Fee*	Nonresident Fee*
Mite-C	\$1,725	\$1,870
Mite-B	\$1,870	\$2,015
Squirt	\$2,845	\$2,990
Peewee	\$2,990	\$3,135
Bantam	\$3,135	\$3,280
Midget Minor	\$1,870	\$2,015
Midget Major	\$1,870	\$2,015

(2) Instructional hockey.

Session	Resident Fee	Nonresident Fee
First session	\$350	\$400
Second session	\$350	\$400

- Mites reduced from full ice to cross-ice.
- Midgets short season ending December 1, 2016.

* The above fees will be reduced by \$500 for goalies for Squirt through Midget levels **All goalies in all Hockey league programs referenced in subparagraph B (1) above shall pay a flat rate registration fee of \$950.00.**

SECTION 3: INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4: PARTIAL INVALIDITY

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

- A. Except as set forth at subparagraphs B and C hereof, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earlier of the following dates: (1) on the date the Mayor affixes his/her signature thereto and returns same to the Municipal Council by delivering it to the Municipal Clerk pursuant to NJSA 40A:69A-41 or (2) on the tenth day following presentment to the Mayor of the Ordinance pursuant to NJSA 40:69A-41 applicable when the Mayor has failed to return the Ordinance; whichever occurs first.
- B. If the Mayor vetoes the Ordinance (in the manner set forth at NJSA 40:69A-41), this Ordinance shall become effective upon the Township Council's vote to override the Mayor's veto.

C. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, this Ordinance shall not take effect less than twenty (20) days after its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor, where such approval is required, unless the Council shall have also adopted a resolution declaring an emergency and at least two thirds (2/3) of all the members of the council vote in favor of such resolution.


