TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 2023-11 ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10 "TRAFFIC", SECTION 10-19.7b. OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Township Council of the Township of Old Bridge, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey that Chapter 10 entitled <u>Traffic</u> Section 10-19.7b entitled "Handicapped parking on street for private residences" be and is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39: 4-197.6, any municipality may, by ordinance, establish a restricted parking zone in front of a residence occupied by a handicapped person, if windshield placard or wheelchair symbol license plates have been issued for a vehicle owned by the handicapped person, or by another occupant of the residence who is a member of the immediate family of the handicapped person, by the Division of Motor Vehicle pursuant to the provisions of NJSA 39: 4-204 et seq. This Ordinance amends the residential parking designation section to include one new residential handicapped parking space set forth herein below.

SECTION 2: 10-19.7b HANDICAPPED PARKING DESIGNATIONS

Section 10-19.7b entitled "Handicapped parking on street for private residences" is hereby amended by the addition of one new residential parking space as follows:

Name of Street 261 Garth Court Location In Front Of Home

SECTION 3: INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4: PARTIAL INVALIDITY

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

- A. Except as set forth at subparagraphs B and C hereof, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earlier of the following dates (1) on the date the Mayor affixes his/her signature thereto and returns same to the Municipal Council by delivering it to the Municipal Clerk pursuant to NJSA 40A:69A-41 or (2) on the tenth day following presentment to the Mayor of Ordinance pursuant to NJSA 40A:69A-41 applicable when the Mayor has failed to return the Ordinance, whichever occurs first.
- B. If the Mayor vetoes the Ordinance (in the manner set forth at 40A:69A-41), this Ordinance shall become effective upon the Township Council's vote to override the Mayor's veto.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, this Ordinance shall not take effect less than twenty (20) days after its final passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor, where such approval is required, unless the Council shall have also adopted a resolution declaring an emergency and at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members of the Council vote in favor of such resolution.
