

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI FOR PLACEMENT OF LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION CAMERAS

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that placement of license plate recognition camera systems at strategic locations in the City will improve the Police Department's ability to deter and investigate crime and enhance public safety; and

WHEREAS, some of the prime locations where such cameras can be most effective are along roadways owned and maintained by St. Louis County and the County will allow placement of the cameras and associated equipment if the City executes a right of way use agreement as hereinafter provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLIVETTE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: The City Council hereby approves on behalf of the City of Olivette, Missouri, an *Agreement for the Installation, Operations, and Maintenance of License Plate Recognition Cameras Within St. Louis County Maintained Right of Way* in substantial conformity with the terms shown on **Exhibit A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set out here in full, together with such changes therein as shall be approved by the officers of the City executing same which are consistent with the provisions and intent of this legislation and necessary, desirable, convenient or proper in order to carry out the matters herein authorized. The Mayor, City Manager, Police Chief, and other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to execute such documents and take any and all actions necessary, desirable, convenient or prudent in order to carry out the intent of this legislation.


Section Two: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the City Council.
