TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION

The following resolution was offered by Councilor Ryan, who moved its adoption, and was seconded by Councilor Mahar, to wit:

**AN ORDER DESIGNATING STOP SIGNS
AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF
GRAY WING LANE AND PROVIDENCE ROAD,
SOUTHWOOD HEIGHTS DRIVE AND PROVIDENCE ROAD AND
PROVIDENCE ROAD AND POWDER HORN LANE**

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT & SEQR

By adoption of this Order, the Town Board of the Town of Onondaga, pursuant to the authority of Section 1660 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, and the Town of Onondaga Codes, Section 270-38, declares its intent to designate the intersections listed below in Section 3 as stop intersections as described. This is a Type II action under SEQR.

SECTION 2. STOP INTERSECTIONS DESIGNATED

The intersection of Gray Wing Lane at Providence Road is hereby designated as a one-way stop intersection for traffic proceeding through said intersection on Gray Wing Lane; and the intersection of Southwood Heights Drive and Providence Road is hereby designated as a one-way stop intersection for the traffic proceeding through said intersection on Southwood Heights Drive; and the intersection of Providence Road and Powder Horn Lane is hereby designated as an all-way stop intersection for the traffic proceeding through the intersection of Providence Road and Powder Horn Lane.

SECTION 3. SECTION 270-38 OF TOWN CODE. SCHEDULE IX: STOP INTERSECTIONS

Schedule IX of Section 270-38 is hereby revised by adding thereto, the following schedule:

Stop Sign On	Direction of Travel	At Intersection Of
Gray Wing Lane	Easterly	Providence Road
Southwood Heights Drive	Easterly	Providence Road
Powder Horn Lane	Easterly and Westerly	Providence Road
Providence Road	Southerly	Powder Horn Lane

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE

This Order shall take effect upon the erection, at the intersections affected by this Order, of signs of the size and design and at the locations prescribed in the State Manual and Specifications prepared by the State Traffic Commission, as required by the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York as amended.

The question of the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly put to a vote, and the vote was as follows:
