

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY

APPROPRIATION N.J.S. 40A:4-54

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oradell, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, that pursuant to N.J.S. 40A:4-54 (Ch. 48, P.L. 1956 as amended by Ch. 144, P.L. 1965 and Ch. 38, P.L. 1969) the sum of \$390,000 is hereby appropriated for the flood damages caused by Hurricane Ida and shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in N.J.S. 40A:4-55.

The authorization to finance the appropriation shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of at least 1/3 of the amount authorized pursuant to this act (N.J.S. 40A:4-55).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
