## Local Law 6-2024

A local law amending chapter 147 (Food Establishments).

### BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 147 (Food Establishments) is amended with new matter <u>underlined</u> and deleted matter in [brackets].

#### § 145-7 **Definitions.**

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

# **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE**

<u>Includes alcohol, spirits, liquor, wine, beer, cider, and every liquid, solid, powder or crystal, patented or not, containing alcohol, spirits, wine or beer and capable of being consumed by a human being.</u>

### LIQUOR

<u>Includes any and all distilled or rectified spirits, brandy, whiskey, rum, gin, cordials or similar alcoholic beverages, including all dilutions and mixtures of one or more of the foregoing.</u>

### **REFRESHMENT BUSINESS**

A business conducted or proposed to be conducted for the sale or offering for sale [at retail] for consumption on the premises where sold, either as a separate business or in connection with any other business, [of] any [malt or vinous] <u>alcoholic</u> beverages, any soft [drink] <u>drinks</u> including tea, coffee, milk, chocolate and cocoa, any carbonated [beverage] <u>beverages</u> and any other [beverage] <u>beverages</u> produced by the process by which beer, ale, porter, wine <u>or spirits</u> [is] <u>are</u> produced.

# **SPIRITS**

Any beverage which contains alcohol obtained by distillation mixed with drinkable water and other substances in solution.

**Section 2.** Effective date.

This local law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State as required by section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
