AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE I OF THE CITY OF OWENSVILLE, MISSOURI MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO TABLE I-A SPEED LIMITS AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF OWENSVILLE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Table I-A Speed Limits of the City of Owensville, Missouri, Municipal Code is hereby amended and shall hereinafter read as follows:

Table I-A Speed Limits

General. Except as may be otherwise allowed by this Schedule and except as otherwise provided in this Chapter, no person shall operate any motor vehicle, other vehicle, or motorized bicycle on any highway, street, or alley within the City at a speed greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Specific Locations. No person shall operate any motor vehicle, other vehicle, or motorized bicycle on any of the following named highways, streets, or alleys at a speed in excess of that hereinafter specified.

Location	Speed Limit
Parker Drive through Memorial Park	15 mph
McCan Drive	15 mph
Water's Edge Drive	30 mph
Missouri Route P	35 mph
Missouri Route 19 within the school zone, when flashers are activated	35 mph
Missouri Route 19 from Missouri Route 28 junction to the south City boundary line	35 mph
South Ninth Street to a point sixty (60) feet east of Krausetown Road	35 mph
Missouri Route 28 from a point sixty (60) feet east of Krausetown Road	
Missouri Route 19 from Missouri Route 28 junction to the north City boundary line	45 mph
Missouri Route 28 from L & D Drive to a point one hundred fifty (150) feet west of South Ninth Street	45 mph
Missouri Route 28 from a point one hundred fifty (150) feet west of to a point four hundred and seventy-five (475) feet west of the east City boundary line	45 mph
Missouri Route 28 from the west City boundary line to L & D Drive	55 mph
Missouri Route 28 from a point four hundred and seventy-five (475) feet west of the east City boundary line to the east City boundary line	55 mph

SECTION TWO: It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Aldermen that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the Board of Aldermen intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part section and subsection, In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: The Chapter, Article, Division and/or Section assignments designed in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of recodifying or servicing the City's Code of ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in the discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be more reasonable. In adjusting such designations, the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code section to accommodate such changes.

SECTION FOUR. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.

READ two (2) times and passed as read this 3rd day of September 2024.


