# MRB LAKESHORE STORM SEWERS

**RESOLUTION NO. 330-2019** Motion by Councilperson Keller, seconded by Councilperson Judd, to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Contract with MRB to provide engineering services to design the shoreline storm sewers in the amount of \$8,600.00 to be funded out of B Engineering.

Gary Hafner asked about the status of the Sanitary Sewers along the lake. Supervisor Barton said he has signed an Agreement with MRB for Engineering Services to design the Sanitary Sewers along the lake from Payne Beach Road to Hamlin Parma Town Line Road. They will be forced mains. Residents would pay approximately 5 cents on the dollars for the installation of the Sanitary Sewers. The Town will hold a Public Hearing to create the Sewer District in the future which will be advertised. If there are enough residents opposed it would have to go to a Referendum. Supervisor Barton is hoping to have all three projects started this year; however, the Sanitary Sewers will not be completed for a couple of years. The State has asked that all projects be completed within three years.
