### RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING ON AMENDING PEEKSKILL ADMINISTRATIVE CODE SECTIONS 290-4 AND 290-47 TO INCREASE PARKING FINES AND METERED PARKING RATES

WHEREAS, the City of Peekskill has an established parking fine and meter rate schedule; and

WHEREAS, the current schedule has not updated the rates in many years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peekskill needs to make capital, structural improvements to the Nelson Street Garage and the James Street Garage; and

WHEREAS, as of this time, the improvements are estimated to cost \$2,500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the city anticipates that it will need to bond for these improvements therefore increasing its debt expenses; and

WHEREAS, the inflation rate between the updates to the rates in 2007 and the proposed updates in 2024 is approximately 48%; and

WHEREAS, the issuance of fines requires additional administrative work; and

WHEREAS, the cost for administrative work has increased since the fine and meter rates were last increased; and

WHEREAS, the costs to maintain the parking meters has also increased since the meter rates were last established; and

#### LOCAL LAW No OF 2024 AMENDING PEEKSKILL ADMINISTRATIVE CODE SECTION 290-4 AND 290-47 TO INCREASE PARKING FINES AND METERED PARKING RATES

## BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Peekskill as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 290-4 of the Peekskill Administrative Code is hereby amended and shall read as follows:

§ 290-4. Penalties for offenses and Local Surcharge Amended 3-10-1986; 9-14-1987; 12-11-1995; 1-28-2002; 10-25-2004; 12-27-2004; 1-10-2005; 9-25-2006; 2-13-2007; 3-12-2007; 12-22-2008; 1-10-20111

A. When any vehicle shall occupy any space adjacent to which a parking meter is located on the streets, or parts of streets, and/or designated municipal parking areas or lots, as listed in Schedule XXVI (§290-101) the operator of said vehicle shall, upon entering said parking space between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday\_except holidays designated by the Common Council, immediately deposit or cause to be deposited in such parking meter the following fee to a maximum time limit for all meters, as is provided in Schedule XXVI (§290-101) of this Chapter, and the failure to deposit same shall constitute a violation of the terms and provisions of this Article.

(1) Twenty-five cents (\$0.25) for each twelve (12) minute increment for metered parking on Requa Street from Railroad Avenue to South Street and twenty-five and 25/100 cents (\$0.25) for each twelve (12) minute increment at all other parking meters.

Section 2. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Common Council.
