## AN ORDINANCE 2117-2023

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE HONORARY NAMING OF PULASKI AVENUE AS PSC PLACE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERTH AMBOY:

SECTION 1. The City acknowledges the contributions of various ethnic groups that make up Perth Amboy.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Chapter 53-3 of the City Code, The Portuguese Sporting Club submitted an application, dated September 1, 2023, along with petitions, requesting that the entire length of Pulaski Avenue shall be designated as "PSC Place" with honorary permanent signage designated "PSC Place" being placed beneath the existing signage designation located on Pulaski Avenue between the intersections of State.

SECTION 3. The Honorary signage shall be in as size and dimension not to exceed six inches by twenty-four inches and shall conform in all aspects to existing signage within the City.

SECTION 4. The current legal addresses for residents and businesses located on Pulaski Avenue shall remain constant and not be affected by this honorary designation.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or part of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 6. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance, but they shall remain in effect, it being legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, publication and approval according to law.
