

ORDINANCE NO. 7-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 104-6, SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED, OF ARTICLE II, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, AND AMENDING SECTION 104-11, PARKING PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS AT ALL TIMES, OF ARTICLE III, PARKING REGULATIONS, BOTH OF CHAPTER 104, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNSBURG, AS AMENDED, TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT ON A PORTION OF SEMINARY STREET AND TO CREATE ADDITIONAL NO-PARKING ZONES ON MAIN STREET.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Pennsburg Borough Council, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 104-6, Speed Limits Established, of Article II, Traffic Regulations, of Chapter 104, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of the Borough of Pennsburg, is hereby amended as it relates to speed limits on Seminary Street as follows:

Name of Street	Speed Limit (mph)	Location
Seminary Street	15	Between 2 nd Street and the entrance/exit to the parking lot at Schumo Hall.

SECTION 2. Section 104-11, Parking Prohibited in Certain Locations at all Times, of Article III, Parking Regulations, of Chapter 104, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Pennsburg, as amended, is hereby amended to prohibit parking on the following portions of Main Street:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Main Street	Both	Between 8 th Street and a point 483 feet north
Main Street	Both	Between 8 th Street and a point 485 feet south
Main Street	East	Between a point 380 feet north of Eighth Street and a point 325 feet south of Seventh Street

Main Street	Both	Between Quakertown Avenue and Third Street
Main Street	West	Between a point 121.8 feet north of Sixth Street and a point 786 feet south of Fifth Street

SECTION 3. The remaining provisions of Chapter 104, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of the Borough of Pennsburg, as amended, to the extent not inconsistent herewith are hereby reenacted and reordained.

SECTION 4. Any section, article or clause of Chapter 104, Vehicles and Traffic, which is inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
