ORDINANCE NO. 2024-11

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$ 1,379,350 FOR FINANCING THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$ 1,354,350 from the Capital Improvement Fund and \$25,000 is hereby appropriated from Reserve for Flood Improvements in aggregate appropriating **\$ 1,379,350** for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

(a) Technology Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not Limited to: Server Upgrades, Printer/ Copiers, Workstation Replacements, and Wireless Access Point Upgrades	\$ 52,250
(b) Fire Department Equipment Including but not Limited to Scott Cylinder Replacements, Hose, Fire Fighting Foam, Water Rescue Equipment, and Vehicle Replacements	\$ 203,000
(c) Traffic and Roadway Improvements Including but not Limited to: Road Resurfacing, Drainage Improvements, Sidewalk Improvements, and Crack Sealing	\$ 368,000
(d) Vehicle Replacements Including but not Limited to Municipal Fleet Vehicles & Animal Control Vehicles	\$ 198,000
(e) Upgrades and Purchases related to Municipal Facilities and Parks Including but not Limited to Improvements and Purchases for: reconstruction of the Greenview Tennis Courts, Police Garage, planting of Shade Trees, and Improvements and Equipment for Park Facilities	\$ 380,000
(f) Police Equipment Purchases Including but not Limited to: Lawsoft Records Management System & a Fingerprint Scanner	\$ 43,100
(g) First Aid Squad Purchases Including but not Limited to an Ambulance	\$ 135,000
TOTAL	\$ 1,379,350

SECTION 2. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final adoption, as provided by law.
