WHEREAS, Subsection 1 of Section 116-2(J) shall be deleted in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

 Subsection 1 of Section 116-2(J) of the Code of the Borough of Penns Grove shall be deleted and replaced with the following;

Any Uniformed Member of the Borough of Penns Grove Police department who is not a party to a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Borough of Penns Grove shall have hours of employment as established by the Chief of Police.
