## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PEVELY, MISSOURI REVISING CHAPTER 200, ARTICLE I, SECTION 200.015 TO ESTABLISH QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES OF THE POLICE PERSONNEL BOARD.

WHEREAS, from time to time the duties and responsibilities of the officials and officers of the City of Pevely ("City") need to be modified to reflect the changes in procedure, technology, education and/or application; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Pevely, Missouri has determined that certain modifications need to be made regarding the Chief of Police;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PEVELY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 200, Article I, Section 200.025 of the City of Pevely, Missouri Municipal Code is hereby revised as follows with the addition of the following language:

The Chief of Police shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Alderman. Issues pertaining to his/her employment shall be exclusively governed by Missouri Statute 106.273. Neither the Mayor nor the Board of Alderman is not required to bring any disciplinary issues regarding the Chief or Police to the Police Personnel Board. Neither the Mayor not the Board of Alderman is not required to consult with the Police Personnel Board regarding the hiring of a new Chief of Police

Section 2. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinctive, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
