# TOWN OF PHILIPSTOWN LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2023

A local law adopting a Community Preservation Plan and amending the Town Code of the Town of Philipstown to add a new Chapter 69 entitled "Community Preservation Plan."

# **SECTION 1. PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this local law is to promote the public health, safety and welfare by adopting a Community Preservation Plan and adding a new Chapter 69 the Town Code of the Town of Philipstown entitled "Community Preservation Plan."

# SECTION 2. MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW:

This law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law §10(1)(ii)(a)(1) which grants local governments the authority to enact local laws regarding the public health, safety and welfare. To the extent the provisions of this Local Law are in conflict with State law, the Town Board hereby asserts its intention to supersede same pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule.

### SECTION 3. ADOPTION OF COMMUNITY PRESERVATION PLAN:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-s of the General Municipal Law, the Town Board hereby adopts the Community Preservation Plan currently on file with the Town Clerk and which is by reference incorporated herein as if fully set forth at length. Provided, however, that the Town is not, at this time, establishing a Community Preservation Fund or enacting any transfer taxes.

### SECTION 4. AMENDMENT OF TOWN CODE:

A new Chapter 69 is hereby added to the Town Code of the Town of Philipstown entitled "Community Preservation Plan" which shall provide as follows:

### "Chapter 69 Community Preservation Plan

§ 69-1 Pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-s of the General Municipal Law, the Town Board hereby adopts the Community Preservation Plan which is on file with the Town Clerk and which is by reference incorporated herein as if fully set forth at length."

## SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be judged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered.

# SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law will take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in Albany.
