TOWNSHIP OF PITTSGROVE ORDINANCE NUMBER 2024-03

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSGROVE, IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING \$880,000.00 THEREFOR FROM CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Township of Pittsgrove, in the County of Salem, State of New Jersey (the "Township"), wishes to undertake various general capital improvements in and throughout the Township including, but not limited to, acquisition and installation, as applicable, of various roadway improvements including, but not limited to, oil and chip process; various Convenience Center improvements, and Municipal Building Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the cost of said improvements or purposes is estimated to be 880,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to authorize the appropriation and expenditure of \$880,000.00 from Capital Improvement Fund of the Township for the purpose of undertaking various general capital improvements in and throughout the Township.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSGROVE, IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (a majority of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The capital improvements or purposes described in Section 2 of this Capital Ordinance are hereby authorized as general capital improvements to be undertaken by the Township. For the said improvements or purposes, there are hereby appropriated the amount of \$880,000.00 from Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to fund the total cost.

SECTION 2. The capital expenditures authorized by this Capital Ordinance include, but are not limited to, various general capital improvements in and throughout the Township including, but not limited to, acquisition various roadway improvements including, but not limited to, oil and chip process; various Convenience Center improvements, and Municipal Building Improvements; Said improvements shall be

on a list on file with the Chief Financial Officer and shall also include, as applicable, all

engineering and design work, surveying, construction planning, preparation of plans and

permits. bid documents, construction inspection

administration, and all work, materials, equipment, labor and appurtenances necessary

therefor or incidental thereto.

SECTION 3. The expenditure of the \$880,000, consisting of an

appropriation of \$880,000 from Capital Improvement Fund of the Township for the

improvements or purposes set forth in Section 2 hereof, is hereby authorized and

approved. The Mayor, the Clerk, the Chief Financial Officer and any other official/officer of

the Township are each hereby authorized and directed to execute, deliver and perform

any agreement to undertake the improvements or purposes set forth herein and to

effectuate the transaction contemplated hereby.

SECTION 4. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to

conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency

herewith and a resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full

detail of the amended capital budget and capital programs as approved by the Director of

the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs

is on file in the Office of the Clerk and is available for public inspection.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final

adoption and approval by the Mayor as described in N.J.S.A. 40:49-2.
