ORDINANCE NO. 408

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PINE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 138 (“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”), ARTICLE IV (“TRAFFIC REGULATIONS”) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PINE, SO AS TO AMEND SECTION 138-9 (DELETING, ADDING, AND CHANGING THE DESCRIPTION OF LOCATIONS FOR CERTAIN STOP SIGNS), AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, Chapter 61 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (75 PA C.S.A. §6010 et seq.) grants authority to local municipalities to ordain reasonable rules and regulations for the control of the movements of motor vehicle traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pine finds that certain amendments to its traffic regulations (as contained in Article IV of Chapter 138 of the Code of the Township of Pine) are necessary so as to promote convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles within and through the Township of Pine and to adequately protect both the safety and welfare of the citizens and residents of the Township of Pine and, also, that of the traveling public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pine, County of Allegheny and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority of Chapter 61 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 PA C.S.A. §6101 et seq. and other applicable law, hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 138, Article IV (“Traffic Regulations”), Section 138-9 (“Stop Intersections”) of the Code of the Township of Pine is hereby amended so as to add authorization for Stop Signs at the following three additional new locations:

12121 Perry Highway (Eden Academy)	West	Wallace Road Extension
701 Mt. Pleasant Road (Emerald Fields Playground)	East	Mt Pleasant Road

Section 2. If a final decision of a court of competent jurisdiction holds any provision of this Ordinance or the application of any provision of this Ordinance or the application of any provision of this Ordinance to any circumstance to be illegal or unconstitutional, the other provisions of this Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other circumstances shall remain in full force and effect. The intention of the Township is that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and that this Ordinance would have been adopted if any such illegal or unconstitutional provisions had not been included.
