Ordinance No. 23-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 215.1530 CERTAIN OFFENDERS NOT TO PHYSICALLY BE PRESENT OR LOITER WITHIN 500 FEET OF CHILD CARE FACILITY – VIOLATION – PENALTY OF CHAPTER 215 OFFENSES, ARTICLE IX SEXUAL OFFENSES, IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PIERCE CITY MISSOURI.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Pierce City, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. That the title of Section 215.1530 be amended to read as follows:

“Section 215.1530. Certain Offenders Not to Physically be Present or Loiter Within 500 Feet of a Public Park, Swimming Pool, Athletic Complex, Museum, Nature Center, or Child Care Facility – Violation – Penalty.”

Section 2. That paragraph 2 of Section 215.1530 be amended to read as follows:

2. Any offense in any other jurisdiction which, if committed in this State, would be a violation listed in this section; shall not knowingly be physically present in or loiter within five hundred (500) feet of any real property comprising any public park with playground equipment, a public swimming pool, athletic complex or athletic fields if such facilities exist for the primary use of recreation for children, any museum if such museum holds itself out to the public as and exists with the primary purpose of entertaining or educating children under eighteen (18) years of age, or child care facility building nor approach, contact, or communicate with any child under eighteen (18) years of age on the real property comprising any of these locations when persons under the age of eighteen (18) are present in the building, on the grounds, or in the conveyance, unless the offender is a parent, legal guardian, or custodian of a child present in the building or on the grounds.”


Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.


