

**CHAPTER 275 – ZONING
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
TOWN OF PITTSFIELD
BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Town Board of the Town of Pittsfield, Brown County, Wisconsin that Chapter 275 – Zoning of the Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows, by the addition of the underlined text and the striking of the crossed out text:


§ 275-26 AG-FP Agricultural Farmland Preservation District.

Lawful uses which are pursuant to the preservation of prime agricultural land for continual farming and which are performed in a manner consistent with the requirements of this chapter shall be permitted in all AG-FP Districts. The Pittsfield Town Board has adopted Chapter 26, Animal Waste Management, of the Brown County Code of Ordinances, and any subsequent changes, into this Code. The following shall apply in AG-FP Districts:


C. Permitted accessory uses.

- (2) Left blank for future use ~~Transmission lines, substations, telephone and telegraph lines, public utility installation, radio and television stations.~~
- (3) Private kennels as defined by the Town Code and consistent with s. 275-8 “Accessory Use” (C).
