

CITY OF PLEASANTVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 4-2024

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PLEASANTVILLE, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 187,
“PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS” IN THE CITY CODE”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Pleasantville, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 187, Parks and Playgrounds, in the City of Pleasantville, is hereby be amended as follows:

SECTION 187-4 ROOM RENTALS

D. Only the party named on the rental agreement shall use the room. Any party found to be subleasing shall be subject up to and including, fines, forfeiture of use of premise now and in the future and possible incarceration pursuant to Section 187-14.

SECTION 187-5 RENTAL AGREEMENTS REQUIRED; CANCELLATION FEE

The rental of the main gymnasium, meeting rooms or multipurpose room is conditional upon the execution of a rental agreement between the City and the applicant utilizing the facilities in a form and containing such provisions as are acceptable to the City. Cancellations made less than two weeks before the event shall be subject to a cancellation fee of 10% of the room rate, to be taken from the 50% deposit. **Only the party named on the rental agreement shall use the room. Any party found to be subleasing shall be subject up to and including, fines, forfeiture of use of premise now and in the future and possible incarceration pursuant to Section 187-14.**

SECTION 187-13 PERMIT REQUIRED FOR PARK USAGE

Persons wishing to use a park or playground for a family picnic and park area must obtain a permit from the Recreation Department. This permit will be issued without charge, upon application by one person over the age of 18 years who shall indicate the names, ages and relationship to the applicant of all persons in the applicant's group. The permit shall be issued upon showing that at least 50% of the persons in the applicant's group are Pleasantville residents. **Only the party named on the permit agreement shall use the park. Any party found to be subleasing shall be subject up to and including, fines, forfeiture of use of premise now and in the future and possible incarceration pursuant to Section 187-14.**
