**A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 173 OF THE VILLAGE CODE
CONCERNING RESTRICTED PARKING SPACES FOR MUNICIPAL
VEHICLES ONLY**

A LOCAL LAW to amend the Pleasantville Code Section 173-72, Schedule XXIV, to provide two parking spaces at the Wheeler Avenue Municipal Parking lot restricted for municipal use only.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Pleasantville as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 173, Article VII, of the Pleasantville Village Code, Section 173-72 entitled “Schedule XXIV: Special Purpose Parking Zones” is hereby amended as follows:

§ 173-72 Schedule XXIV: Special Purpose Parking Zones.

In accordance with the provisions of § 173-28, the following are hereby established as special purpose parking zones:

Bedford Road Parking Lot	Both	Handicapped parking	Bedford Road Parking Lot

Clinton Street	South	Handicapped parking	From a point 80 feet west of the High School circle to a point 124 feet west
Sunnyside Avenue		Handicapped parking	From a point 96 feet south of Bedford Road south for 20 feet
Tompkins Avenue Parking Lot	West and east	Church staff vehicles only/ All days/All hours	Designated spaces at the west and east side of lot
Wheeler Avenue	West	Police cars only	One designated space in front of 80 Wheeler Avenue
<u>Wheeler Avenue Parking Lot</u>		<u>Municipal vehicles only</u>	<u>Two parking spaces as designated by signs</u>

Section 2. Ratification, Re-adoption and Confirmation

Except as specifically modified by the amendments contained herein, Chapter 173 of the Village Code of the Village of Pleasantville are otherwise to remain in full force and effect and are otherwise ratified, readopted and confirmed.

Section 3. Numbering for Codification

It is the intention of the Village of Pleasantville and it is hereby enacted that the provisions of this Local Law shall be included in the Code of the Village of Pleasantville; that the sections and subsections of this Local Law may be re-numbered or re-lettered by the Codifier to accomplish such intention; that the Codifier shall make no substantive changes to this Local Law; that the word “ Local Law” shall be changed to “Chapter,” “ Section” or other appropriate word as required for codification; and that any such rearranging of the numbering and editing shall not affect the validity of this Local Law or the provisions of the Code affected thereby.

Section 4. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this chapter or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision,

section, or part of this chapter, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6. Effective date.

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
