## **ORDINANCE NO. 24-24**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES AND REVISING THE ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

**Section 1.** Chapter 2, "Administration," Section 2-42.2, "Composition of the Police Department", Subsection A., of the Municipal Code of the Borough of Pompton Lakes, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

- A. The total number of sworn Officers shall not exceed 26. It shall consist of the following:
- 1. One (1) Chief of Police;
- 2. Not less than one (1) nor more than two (2) Police Captains;
- 3. Not less than two (2) nor more than three (3) Police Lieutenants;
- 4. Not less than four (4) nor more than five (5) Police Sergeants;
- 5. Not less than twelve (12) nor more than sixteen (16) Police Officers.

**Section 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent necessary.

**Section 3.** If any article, section, subsection, term or condition of this Ordinance is declared invalid or illegal for any reason, the balance of the Ordinance shall be deemed severable and shall remain in full force and effect.
