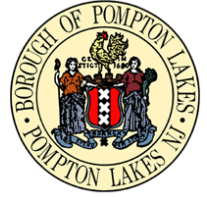

ORDINANCE NO. 24-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, SECTION 7-43.1, "HANDICAPPED PARKING ON STREETS", OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF POMPTON LAKES TO UPDATE THE DESCRIPTION OF THE LINCOLN AVENUE PARKING SPACE

WHEREAS, the measurements of the handicapped parking space located on Lincoln Avenue have recently changed as a result of the relocation of the spot during paving operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Pompton Lakes, Passaic County, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 7, Section 7-43, "Handicapped Parking on Streets", of the Municipal Code of the Borough of Pompton Lakes, is hereby amended, with this Ordinance, to update the description of the Lincoln Avenue parking space as follows:

Street	Side	Location
Lincoln Avenue	East	Beginning at a point 391 feet northerly from the extension lines of the northly curblineline of Riverview Road and the easterly curblineline of Lincoln Ave. and extending to a point 22 feet northerly therefrom.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent necessary.

Section 3. If any article, section, subsection, term or condition of this Ordinance is declared invalid or illegal for any reason, the balance of the Ordinance shall be deemed severable and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after approval of the Mayor or in accordance with law and publication and passage according to law.
