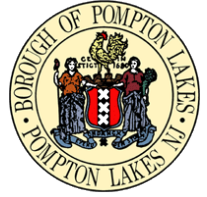

ORDINANCE NO. 24-33

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF POMPTON LAKES (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL)

Section 1. Chapter 6, "Alcoholic Beverage Control," Section 6-1.5, "License Fees; Maximum Number," of the Municipal Code of the Borough of Pompton Lakes, is hereby amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

§ 6-1.5. License Fees; Maximum Number.

The annual fees and maximum number of licenses for the sale or distribution of alcoholic beverages in the Borough shall be as follows:

<u>CLASS OF LICENSE:</u>	<u>FEE:</u>	<u>MAXIMUM NUMBER:</u>
Plenary Retail Consumption License	\$1,200	8
Plenary Retail Distribution License	\$1,200	6
Club License	\$80	5

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent necessary.

Section 3. If any article, section, subsection, term or condition of this Ordinance is declared invalid or illegal for any reason, the balance of the Ordinance shall be deemed severable and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after approval of the Mayor or in accordance with law and publication and passage according to law.
