**Local Law No. 4 of the year 2026**  
**A local law be it enacted by the: Board of Trustees of the**  
**Village of PORT JEFFERSON**  
**as follows:**

Chapter 250

**PURPOSE**

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 250 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF PORT JEFFERSON ENTITLED “ZONING” ARTICLE XII “PLANNING BOARD” SECTION 51-A “ESTABLISHMENT.”

Section 1. Legislative Intent. This Local Law would amend the Code to increase the number of members on the Village of Port Jefferson Planning Board from five (5) to seven (7) members.

Section 2. Text Amendment. The proposed local law would amend Chapter 250 of the Code of the Village of Port Jefferson “ZONING” Article XII “PLANNING BOARD” Section 51-A “ESTABLISHMENT.”, by adding the underlined (\_\_\_\_) words and deleting the struck out words (——) as follows:

Chapter 250 – Zoning

Article XII – Planning Board

Sec. 51 – Establishment.

- A. There shall be a Planning Board of ~~five~~ seven members pursuant to the provisions of § ~~7-7128~~ of the Village Law.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article, chapter or part of this local shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article, chapter or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 4. Authority to enact pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law § 10, § 20 and Village Law § 7-718.



Section 5. This local law shall become effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
