# LOCAL LAW 2023-2, A LOCAL LAW AMENDING ARTICLE V OF CHAPTER 149 ENTITELD "TAXATION" THAT INCREASES THE INCOME LIMITS FOR THE EXEMPTION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES:

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Pompey, Onondaga County, New York as follows:

Section 1. Article V, Section 149-13 of Chapter 149 of the Town Code is ammended as follows:

# §149-13 Exemption granted.

Pursuant to § 459-c of the Real Property Tax Law, real property owned by persons with disabilities whose incomes are limited by reason of such disabilities shall be exempt from taxation to the extent set forth below:
