

**POLK TOWNSHIP, MONROE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 05 OF 2023**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ALL WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF
STECKEL ROAD AND SHERWOOD DRIVE**

WHEREAS, The Polk Township Board of Supervisors owns and maintains various township roadways including Steckel Road (T-448); and

WHEREAS, there are also various private roads in the Township including Sherwood Drive (private) and Lincoln Green Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Township is responsible for the installation of traffic control devices, including stop signs, to ensure the safe operation of motor vehicles and flow of traffic on such roads described above; and

WHEREAS, presently there is a two way stop at the intersection of Steckel Road (T-448) and Sherwood Drive (private); and

WHEREAS, the Township engineer has studied the intersection and issued a report dated August 1, 2023 making recommendation for a four way stop at said intersection; and

WHEREAS, an Ordinance is required in order to establish STOP control on roads within the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ADOPTED and ORDAINED as follows:

1. The intersection of Steckel Road (T-448) and Sherwood Drive (private) shall be converted to an ALL WAY STOP intersection, with a stop sign control at each approach, including the adjacent Lincoln Green Drive approach.
2. A stop sign will be installed at both the northbound and southbound approaches of Steckel Road into the intersection.


3. An ALL WAY plaque shall be mounted below each stop sign.
4. A STOP AHEAD sign should be installed in the northbound approach of Steckel Road into the intersection at a distance of approximately one hundred twenty-five (125) feet in advance of the intersection.
5. A flashing red beacon should be mounted on the new stop sign on the Steckel Road northbound approach maintained until traffic becomes accustomed to the sign.
6. The Township shall provide appropriate signage in accordance with applicable regulations and install such signage and maintain the same in accordance with this ordinance.
