

**CITY OF PROSSER, WASHINGTON  
ORDINANCE NO. 26-3313**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROSSER MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 5.05  
MOBILE/NOMADIC VENDOR AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;  
ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR  
PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Prosser seeks to support mobile and temporary business activity while protecting public health, safety, accessibility, traffic circulation, parking, and the general welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City currently regulates nomadic vendors under Chapter 5.05 of the Prosser Municipal Code and desires to update those regulations to make them clearer and easier to administer for applicants, property owners, business owners, staff, and enforcement officials; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that clear application requirements, site standards, operating standards, and approval criteria help ensure that nomadic vendor activities are conducted safely and compatibly with surrounding properties and existing businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that updating Chapter 5.05 of the Prosser Municipal Code is necessary to clarify requirements, improve consistency, support efficient administration, and protect public health, safety, and welfare;

**NOW THEREFORE**, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROSSER, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Prosser Municipal Code Section 5.05 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**5.05.010 Purpose.**

The purpose of this chapter is to allow mobile and temporary vending in a manner that supports local business activity while protecting public health, safety, traffic circulation, parking, accessibility, fire safety, and the appearance and use of surrounding properties.

**5.05.020 Definitions.**

For purposes of this chapter:

- A. **“Approved mobile vendor site”** means a specific property and specific location on that property that has completed mobile vendor site review and has been approved by the city for mobile vendor operation, subject to any conditions of approval.
- B. **“City”** means the City of Prosser, Washington.
- C. **“Food”** means any item intended for human consumption, including prepared food, packaged food, beverages, candy, dairy products, and similar items.
- D. **“License”** means a license issued under this chapter, including a nomadic vendor license or roving vendor license. A license authorizes the vendor to conduct activity within the city, subject

conditions, and staff guidance for applicants and property owners.

**5.05.990 Severability.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph, phrase, or word of this chapter is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the decision does not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this chapter.

**Section 2. SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this ordinance shall not as a result of said section, sentence, clause, or phrase be held unconstitutional or invalid.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.


