

NOTICE OF ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

April 27, 1983

Town of Putnam

The Electors and Citizens qualified to vote in Town Meetings of the Town of Putnam, Connecticut, met in Annual Town Meeting in the Putnam High School Auditorium on Schoolhouse Drive, Putnam, on the 27th day of April, 1983, at 7:30 o'clock in the evening for the following purposes:

#1: Selectman St. Onge was elected Moderator, on motion by Mrs. Newth, 2nd by Mr. Simmons, and so voted.

2: VOTED: that appropriations be made for the fiscal year budget for the period beginning July 1, 1983 and ending June 30, 1984, and to make such appropriations as are advisable.

Motion made by Mr. Garceau, 2nd by Mr. Nichols, and so voted.

3: VOTED: that appropriations be made for the expenditure of General Revenue Sharing monies for fiscal year 1983-1984 budget, and to make such appropriations as are advisable.

Motion made by Mr. DePetrillo, 2nd by Mr. Nichols and so voted.

4: VOTED: that appropriations be made for the expenditure of Town Aid monies for the fiscal year 1983-1984 budget, and to make such appropriations as are advisable.

Motion made by Mr. Simmons, 2nd by Mr. Nichols and so voted.

5: VOTED: RESOLVED: that the Board of Selectmen, acting as agents of the Town of Putnam be authorized to apply for and receive any state or federal grants that may become available and appear to them to be in the best interest of the Town of Putnam.

Motion made by Mrs. Karkutt, 2nd by Mr. Nichols, and so voted.

6: VOTED: TO ADOPT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE: to regulate and Limit Tag Sales:

Be it ordained by the Town of Putnam, at a Town Meeting held April 27, 1983, that:

1. No person may hold a tag sale in the Town of Putnam without having first obtained a license therefor, such license to be issued by the Town Selectmen upon proper application.

2. "Tag Sale" as used herein, shall refer to the sale of new or used merchandise upon private property outside the confines of any building or permanent structure, whether designated "tag sale", "Garage sale", "Yard Sale", "Moving sale", or the like.

3. There shall be no charge for the issuance of a tag .

4. Within any calendar year, no more than two (2) tag sale licenses shall be issued to any person, or family residing in same dwelling or for the conducting of such a sale at any one property.

5. For the purposes of this ordinance, each separate day upon which a sale is held shall be deemed to be a separate "tag sale" and a license is required for each day.

6. Any person conducting a "tag sale" without a license shall be chargeable for this offense, and a fine levied not to exceed \$ 100 dollars.

This ordinance to take effect 15 days after publication.

The motion to adopt this ordinance was made by Mr. Simmons, 2nd by Mr. Garceau. There were 14 votes for adoption, 4 opposed.
