WHEREAS, a project for the construction of a new sewer line extension on Rock Cut Road from Sterling Ridge Drive to Van Alstyne Drive is being progressed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer approved the letting of bids for the project on July 18, 2007; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2007 the bids were opened and reviewed by H.V. Labarba and Associates and the lowest responsible bidder was Lash Contracting, who proposes to construct the sewer line for a cost of Thirty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$35,900.00).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer does hereby resolve and authorize the Mayor of the City of Rensselaer to sign all documents on behalf of the City of Rensselaer to affect an agreement with Lash Contracting for the construction of the Rock Cut Road sewer extension for the amount of Thirty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$35,900.00) and that this project will be paid for from the Sewer Line Impact fee fund that was established in part to pay for this project.

INCLUDE CHANGE ORDER #4 AS PART OF THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW SCHOOL ACCESS ROAD
(PIN 1MS002.30A)**

WHEREAS, a project for the construction of an access road that will connect the new Rensselaer City Schools campus with Tenth Street PIN # 1MS002.30A ("the Project") is being progressed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has secured funding through the New York State Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2006 the bids were opened and the lowest responsible bidder was Rifenburg Construction at Three Million Eight Hundred Sixty One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Forty-Eight Cents (\$3,861,915.48). This price includes the base bid and Alternate Bids #1 – Waterline south, Alternate Bid #2 – Sanitary Force Main and Alternate Bid #3 – Streambed Restoration. The bid for this work was awarded at the September 6th, 2007 meeting of the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer. Alternate Bid # 4 for Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Two Dollars and Seventeen Cents (\$99,992.17) was awarded in September of 2006 for a new total of Three Million Nine Hundred Sixty One Thousand Nine Hundred Seven Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$3,961,907.65).

WHEREAS, subsequent change orders deducted Fifty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Seven Dollars and Seventy-Eight Cents (\$58,947.78) from the project totals for a new total of Three Million Nine Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Nine Thousand Dollars and Eighty-Seven Cents (\$3,902,959.87). This latest change order, #4 will add One Hundred Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars and Fifty-Seven Cents (\$130,819.57) to the cost of the project for field costs approved by the engineering firm of Clark Patterson Associates and will bring the total construction contract to Four Million Thirty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars and Forty-Four Cents (\$4,033,779.44).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer does hereby resolve and authorize the Mayor of the City of Rensselaer to sign all documents on behalf of the City of Rensselaer to affect an agreement with Rifenburg Construction of Troy, New York for Change Order #4 for a cost of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars and Fifty-Seven Cents (\$130,819.57).

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT NEW STREET SIGNS ON TENTH STREET, OLD WASHINGTON AVENUE AND THE NEW SCHOOL ACCESS ROAD

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer seeks to adopt new street signs on Old Washington Avenue, Tenth Street and the new school access road in order to protect public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, these street signs are part of the design of the new road and environs as developed by Clark Patterson Associates and the required public hearing was held on August 15, 2007.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer shall adopt the follow new street signs as part of the redesign of the new school access road and environs:

- On the new school access road there is a no parking zone on both sides of the new access road, a twenty five mile per hour speed limit sign on the new access road and a new stop sign at the intersection of the new access road and Tenth Street.
- On Tenth Street there are two new stop signs; one on each side of the intersection of the new school access road and a no parking zone on either side of Tenth Street from the new school access road west to the intersection with Old Washington Avenue and east to the painted crosswalk adjacent to the entrance to the new school access road.
- On Old Washington Avenue there is a no parking zone on the west side of the street from the beginning of the new on street parking spaces for approximately forty feet south to the intersection of Washington Avenue, and there is a no parking zone on the east side of the street from the intersection of Old Washington Avenue and Tenth Street to a point approximately One Hundred Fifty feet (150') south.




